

It's Your Serve

John 13:1-17, Philippians 2:1-11

Jesus served the disciples by washing their feet. (John 13:1-11)

Jesus' service was motivated by love. (v.1)

Jesus' service exhibited amazing humility. (vv. 2-5)

Jesus' service was unconditional. (vv. 6-11)

Jesus washed the disciples' feet to instruct them on the importance of serving others. (vv. 12-17)

Jesus provided the supreme example of servant leadership.
(vv.12-14)

Jesus stated His expectation that His disciples would follow His example. (vv. 15-16)

Jesus promised His blessing for those who follow His lead. (v. 17)

As Christ followers, we too, are expected to humbly and lovingly serve others. (Phil. 2:1-11)

Questions for Discussion and Further Reflection

1. What is the difference between conditional and unconditional service?
2. What do you think was going through Jesus' mind as He was washing the feet of Judas Iscariot, knowing that Judas was about to betray Him?
3. Who is it that you would have the hardest time "washing their feet," and what would God have you do about it?
4. Where's your E-G-O today? Are you Exalting God Only or Edging God Out?
5. When was the last time God blessed you immaterially? Are you readily aware of God's immaterial blessings to you?
6. Do you tend to serve for affirmation, or are you confident in who you are in Christ?
